


Private Russell Morgan Edmunds No.4 Commando



Commando Wounded

During Second Front Operations

Sad news from the War Office was received by Mr M. Edmunds and Nurse Edmunds, 61 Parish Road, Tynant, on Friday that their son, Pte. Russell Edmunds, Commando Regt., had been wounded in action.

Russell has been in the Army 15 months, first joining the Gloucester Regt. and transferring to the Commandoes on completion of training. Prior to entering the Army he was in the local Home Guard and apprenticed to the motor trade at Beard's garage, Pontypridd. Russel is an old Beddau School boy, and the first local boy to be wounded in the Second Front. He has a shrapnel wound in the head and is now in a military hospital somewhere in Engiand. His many pals are very anxious about him and wish him a speedy recovery. Latest news from the hospital is that he is making favourable progress. He is 19½ years of age.
